Additional Notes:

- Voted YES on HB2803 which allows the state treasurer to securely use bullion for the state's depository.
- Co-sponsored **HB2795** which establishes five paths for the citizens of TN to nullify unconstitutional federal overreach.
- Failed to move that **HB1615**, which would limit executive orders without legislative approval, be heard in committee.
- Voted NO on HB1841 which prohibits certain foreign entities from contracts for TN or its political subdivisions.
- Did not second **HB2648**, which would have canceled permitless carry.
- Co-sponsored HJR0038, which proposes a TN constitutional amendment to clarify that citizens have a right to keep and bear arms for their own defense.
