Illegal Immigration	HB1872 / SB2770	Increase the penalty for illegals convicted of violent crimes.	Yes	Yes
Limited Government	HB0640 / SB0479	Redefines money and paves the way for a Central Bank Digital Currency (CBDC). Was amended to replace all the bad text with a simple statement that CBDCs are not bank accounts in Tennessee.	Yes	Yes
	HB1695 / SB2020	Allows the state to hide autopsies to avoid public scrutiny.	No	Yes
	HB1894 / SB1903	Defines food with a vaccine or vaccine material as a drug.	Yes	Yes
	HB2063 / SB2691	Prohibits the spraying of chemicals and particulates, known as geo-engineering, into our air.	Yes	Yes
	HB2119 / SB1983	Requires the government to prove that eminent domain is in the best interest of the public before taking or condemning property.	Yes	Yes
	HJR0820	Opposes expansion of the World Health Organization's authority and supports ending U.S. government funding of the organization.	Yes	N/A
Medical Freedom	HB1726 / SB2359	Ends the immunization requirement to adopt or foster a child.	Yes	Yes
	HB1883 / SB1641	Allows daily hospital visits, even during a state of emergency.	Yes	Yes
	HB2861 / SB2151	Prohibits vaccination coercion and requirement deception.	Yes	Yes
Second Amendment	SJR0904	Proposes a TN constitutional amendment to clarify that citizens have a right to keep and bear arms for their own defense.	Yes	Yes

Additional Notes:

- Voted **Present-Not Voting** on **SB1858** which allows parents to sue to remove pornography from our schools.
- Voted **Present-Not Voting** on **SB2631** where voters would declare their party or choose "unaffiliated" prior to voting in a primary election.
- Voted **YES** on **SB2735** which would allow the state treasurer to securely produce, store, process, and ship bullion for the state's depository.
- Voted **YES** on **SB2737** which authorizes the treasurer to purchase precious metals.
