<a href="#"><u>HB2018/SB1486</u></a>	<p><b>Illegal Immigration</b> - As introduced, requires a memorandum of understanding entered between a LEA and federal officials concerning enforcement of federal immigration laws to include a requirement that the LEA accept and honor any immigration detainer received from federal immigration authorities, including maintaining custody of the subject of an immigration detainer for 48 hours beyond the time when the subject would have otherwise been released to allow federal immigration authorities to take custody of the subject and notifying federal immigration authorities ASAP prior to releasing the subject.</p>	<b>SUPPORT</b>	Not Assigned	TBD
