HB1897/SB2124	Election Integrity - As introduced, requires each county election commission to check each applicant with the systematic alien verification for entitlements (SAVE) program database prior to placing a registrant on the voter rolls in order to ensure non-U.S. citizens are not registered to vote in the county; requires, at least once each quarter, the county election commission to check the county's entire voter registration list through the SAVE program database to ensure that non-U.S. citizens are not on the voter rolls in the county. HB2018/SB1486	Illegal Immigration - As introduced, requires a memorandum of understanding entered between a LEA and federal officials concerning enforcement of federal immigration laws to include a requirement that the LEA accept and honor any immigration detainer received from federal immigration authorities, including maintaining custody of the subject of an immigration detainer for 48 hours beyond the time when the subject would have otherwise been released to allow federal immigration authorities to take custody of the subject and notifying federal immigration authorities ASAP prior to releasing the subject.
