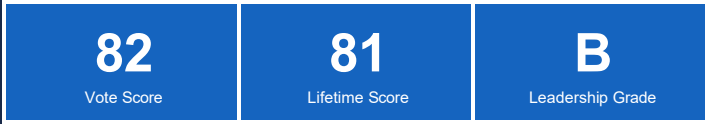

NAUGHTY & NICE — Notable Votes & Sponsorships

- Voted YES in committee and on floor for HB0469 – Landlord firearms rights.
- Voted YES in committee and on floor for HB1705 – E-Verify for government employers.
- Voted YES in committee (twice) and on floor for HB1706 – Illegal immigrants cannot drive commercial vehicles. (Sponsor)
- Voted YES in committee (twice) and on floor for HB1710 – Citizenship verification for public benefits.
- Voted YES in committee for HB0886 – Party registration / closing primaries (Support bill, failed on floor).
- SPONSOR – HB1706 (Passed): Illegal immigrants cannot operate commercial motor vehicles.
- Voted YES on HB1473 – Private citizens not required to recognize same sex marriage.
- Voted YES on HB1788 – Foreign entities banned from buying Tennessee land.
- Voted YES on HB2082 – Parent raising child per biological sex is not abuse.
- Voted YES on HB1971 – NAUGHTY VOTE: Voted for bill preventing citizens from challenging unconstitutional laws without standing. TCGC Opposes.
- No vote recorded on HB2514 (Threaten deadly force trespasser — Senate deferred 2027; House had floor vote).
