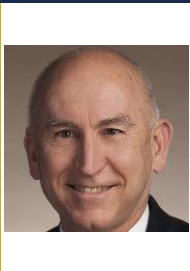

NAUGHTY & NICE — Notable Votes & Sponsorships

- Voted No on SB1028 – NAUGHTY: All ballots cast by a voter in primary/general elections must have a visible secure watermark.
- Voted No on SB1029 – NAUGHTY: Makes changes to the process of voting absentee with regards to federal uniformed and overseas citizens.
- Voted abstain on SB1889 – NAUGHTY: A restricted driver's license will be issued for one year only for individuals who don't speak or read English.
- SPONSOR – Voted Yes on SB2064 – NAUGHTY: Referendum election to raise a real property tax rate by an amount that exceeds the previous limitations.
- Voted No on SB2657 – NAUGHTY: enacts the "Restoring State Sovereignty Through Nullification Act," assembly may nullify an unconstitutional federal act.
- SPONSOR – Voted Yes on SB0305 – any organization or entity that receives money from the state cannot deny benefits or participation based on DEI.
- SPONSOR – Voted Yes on SB0366 – Requires board of elections to verify monthly the voter rolls with regards to non-citizens.
- SPONSOR – Voted Yes on SB0367 – Requires board of elections to verify monthly voter rolls w/ regards to non-citizens. Verify via SAVE database.
- Voted Yes on SB1748 – An "out of service order" will be issued to a commercial driver who is unable to read and speak English.
- SPONSOR – SB0148 (2022): Sponsored legislation to allow vaccinations without parental consent.
- Voted against SB2290 (2022) – Legislation to prevent modern-day racism.
- Voted against SB2188 (2022) – Making Ivermectin available over-the-counter in Tennessee.
- Refused to vote on SB1059 (2022) – Legislation protecting children from obscene materials.
- Killed SB1092 (2022) – Legislation to restore Tennessee state sovereignty; refused to 2nd the bill in committee.
- Voted against SB1111 (2022) – Requiring parental/guardian consent before vaccinating a child.
- SPONSOR – SB0137 (2025): Sponsored legislation approving development projects without public input.
- Would not vote on SB0178 in 2025 – Expanding citizen input at public meetings (Senate companion to HB0022). TCGC Supports.
- SPONSOR – SB0229 (2025): Sponsored bill to fund weaponization of government entities against conservative candidates and groups.
- Killed SB0777 (2025) – Bill to close Tennessee primary elections; refused to 2nd the bill in committee.
- Voted against SB1040 (2025) – Prohibiting out-of-state PACs from influencing primary elections.
- Voted NO on SB0836 (2025) – Schools refusing enrollment to students unlawfully present in the United States.
- Voted against SB0990 (2026) – Requiring verification of legal work authorization.
- Voted against SB2636 (2026) – Homeschool freedoms legislation.
- Voted against SB0259 (2026) – Parental rights in children's healthcare.
- Voted against SB1048 (2026) – Preventing government overreach.
