NAUGHTY & NICE — Notable Votes & Sponsorships

- Voted abstain on HB2202 – NAUGHTY: Expands the designation of scenic rivers that will not allow a landfill for solid or hazardous wastes to be established near its boundaries. This would include the Big South Fork of the Cumberland River.
- Voted Yes on HB0882 – the department of environment and conservation cannot regulate farming activities regarding topsoil, rock removal, or building of a pond if area is less than 3 acres and is considered a greenbelt area.
- Voted Yes on HB0898 – Each utility system shall obtain a certificate of analysis for any water sold by the utility system that contains fluoride.
- Voted Yes on HB2514 – A person protecting their property can threaten deadly force on a trespasser who refuses to leave.
