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NAUGHTY & NICE — Notable Votes & Sponsorships

- Voted YES in committee and on floor for HB0022 – Public meetings must allow public comment.
- Voted YES in subcommittee and committee (twice) for HB1710 – Citizenship verification for public benefits.
- Voted YES in committee and on floor for HB1788 – Foreign entities banned from buying TN land.
- Voted YES in committee (twice) and on floor for HB2018 – Law enforcement must honor immigration detainers.
- Voted YES on HB1706 – Illegal immigrants cannot operate commercial motor vehicles.
- Voted YES on HB1705 – E-Verify for all state and local government employers.
- Voted YES on HB1473 – Private citizens not required to recognize same sex marriage.
- Voted YES on HB2082 – Parent raising child per biological sex is not abuse.
- Voted YES on HB1971 – NAUGHTY VOTE: Voted for bill preventing citizens from challenging unconstitutional laws without standing. TCGC Opposes.
- Voted YES on HB1968 – NAUGHTY: Voted to excuse drug companies (Alvogen, Apotex, Zydus) from opioid claims. TCGC Opposes.
- Voted YES on HB1837 – NAUGHTY: Bill strengthens developer property rights over local land use. TCGC Opposes.
- Chair, Population Health Subcommittee: HB0570 (Personhood) and HB1852 (mRNA ban) both failed for lack of motion in her subcommittee
