NAUGHTY & NICE — Notable Votes & Sponsorships

- Voted No on HB1072 – NAUGHTY: Govt cannot add criteria that will create a wetland where it was previously converted cropland.
- Voted Yes on HB0469 – A landlord cannot deny a tenant on leased property from lawfully possessing, carrying, storing a firearm or ammunition.
- Voted Yes on HB0882 – the department of environment and conservation cannot regulate farming activities regarding topsoil, rock removal, or building of a pond if area is less than 3 acres and is considered a greenbelt area.
- Voted Yes on HB0898 – Each utility system shall obtain a certificate of analysis for any water sold by the utility system that contains fluoride.
- Voted Yes on HB1705 – Requires state and local governments to verify citizenship status using E-Verify.
- Voted Yes on HB1706 – Illegal immigrants cannot lawfully operate a commercial motor vehicle in TN.
- Voted Yes on HB1708 – A restricted driver's license will be issued for one year only for individuals who don't speak or read English.
- Voted Yes on HB1817 – An "out of service order" will be issued to a commercial driver who is unable to read and speak English.
- Voted Yes on HB2202 – Expands the designation of scenic rivers that will not allow a landfill for solid or hazardous wastes to be established near its boundaries. This would include the Big South Fork of the Cumberland River.
- Voted Yes on HB2396 – Prohibits fluoride from being added to public water systems.
- Voted Yes on HB2514 – A person protecting their property can threaten deadly force on a trespasser who refuses to leave.
