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NAUGHTY & NICE — Notable Votes & Sponsorships

- Voted YES in committee on HB0809 (Monsanto Bill) – NAUGHTY: Voted to advance pesticide manufacturer liability shield through Agriculture Subcommittee and Committee. TCGC opposes. Bill was ultimately killed in House Judiciary. Fritts has stated publicly through his office that he regrets this committee vote, that he received information on this bill after the committee vote was taken that would have changed his vote to a NO.
- SPONSOR – HB1852 (Failed): mRNA vaccine prohibition. Fought to ban mRNA vaccines statewide.
- SPONSOR – HB0934 (Taken Off Notice): Authenticate the Voter Act — stronger voter ID requirements.
- SPONSOR – HB2514 (Senate Deferred 2027): Threaten deadly force against trespasser defending property.
- SPONSOR – HB1737 (No Action): Restore firearms rights after pardon, expungement, civil rights restored.
- SPONSOR – HB2419 (Failed): Annexation requires financial study and majority county approval.
- SPONSOR – HB1716 (Failed): Property taxes assessed at last price paid — protection against reassessment.
- SPONSOR – HJR0051 (Passed): Recognizes the month of July as a period of prayer and fasting.
- Voted YES on HB0793 – Schools may refuse to enroll illegal aliens.
- Voted YES on HB0882 – Protects small farm areas (under 3 acres) from Dept. of Environment regulation.
- Voted YES on HB0898 – Certificate of analysis required for fluoridated public water systems.
- Voted YES on HB1072 – Prevents govt from designating converted cropland as new wetlands.
- Voted YES on HB1959 – Pharmacy benefits managers cannot hold ownership interest in pharmacies.
- Voted YES on HB2202 – Expands scenic river protection; prohibits landfills near Big South Fork.
- Voted NO on HB2095 – GOOD VOTE: Against Univ. of TN black fly suppression program. TCGC Opposes.
- Voted NO on HB2313 – GOOD VOTE: Against early childhood mental health home visiting program. TCGC Opposes.
- Voted NO on HB0653 – GOOD VOTE: Against bill funding weaponization of government entities targeting conservative candidates and groups.
