NAUGHTY & NICE — Notable Votes & Sponsorships

- Voted Yes on HB0387 – Prohibits health care provider from asking if patient has or can obtain firearms.
- Voted Yes on HB0469 – A landlord cannot deny a tenant on leased property from lawfully possessing, carrying, storing a firearm or ammunition.
- Voted Yes on HB0853 – Parents and legal guardians will have access to all medical records resulting in treatments for their child.
- Voted Yes on HB1528 – A wrongful death of an unborn child beginning at fertilization is included in the definition for wrongful death action.
- Voted Yes on HB1665 – Healthcare providers cannot ask a minor any gender-related question unless by parent permission.
- Voted Yes on HB1705 – Requires state and local governments to verify citizenship status using E-Verify.
- Voted Yes on HB1959 – Starting Jan 1 2027, no pharmacy benefits manager may directly or indirectly hold, control or otherwise possess any ownership or benefit in a pharmacy license or license holder.
- Voted Yes on HB2166 – A blood bank/hospital must allow a patient to use their own blood which has been saved.
- Voted No on HB2313 – Early childhood mental health home visiting program will be established by the Dept of Health for vulnerable families.
- Voted Yes on HB2498 – TennCare will not provide coverage or reimbursement if the procedure is for gender dysphoria or gender identity disorder.
