NAUGHTY & NICE — Notable Votes & Sponsorships

- Voted No on HB1160 – NAUGHTY: a report shall be submitted to the general assembly of each drug that is considered a psychotropic medication and its side effects.
- Voted abstain on HB2313 – NAUGHTY: Early childhood mental health home visiting program will be established by the Dept of Health for vulnerable families.
- Voted Yes on HB2532 – NAUGHTY: Awards 15,000 additional education scholarships in the 26/27 school year under the One, Big, Beautiful Act if Governor complies w/ all requirements of the Fed.
- Voted Yes on HB0387 – Prohibits health care provider from asking if patient has or can obtain firearms.
- Voted Yes on HB0793 – Public schools and public charter may refuse to enroll illegal aliens.
- Voted Yes on HB1665 – Healthcare providers cannot ask a minor any gender-related question unless by parent permission.
- Voted Yes on HB2514 – A person protecting their property can threaten deadly force on a trespasser who refuses to leave.
