NAUGHTY & NICE — Notable Votes & Sponsorships

- Voted No on SB0162 – NAUGHTY: Prohibits fluoride from being added to public water systems.
- Voted No on SB0474 – NAUGHTY: Prohibits health care provider from asking if patient has or can obtain firearms.
- Voted Yes on SB1495 – NAUGHTY: Alvogen, Inc., Apotex Corp., and Zydus Pharmaceuticals (USA) Inc are included to be excused from pending or future opioid claims.
- Voted No on SB1743 – NAUGHTY: A wrongful death of an unborn child beginning at fertilization is included in the definition for wrongful death action.
- Voted Yes on SB1868 – NAUGHTY: A child who has exhibited or threatened violent behavior is one who is in need of heightened supervision.
- Voted Yes on SB1958 – NAUGHTY: Bill will prevent organizations/citizens from suing regarding unconstitutional legislation unless they have standing. Bill Amended to read: Specifies that such cause of action does not apply to challenges to the validity or constitutionality of state law.
- Voted Yes on SB2153 – NAUGHTY: Early childhood mental health home visiting program will be established by the Dept of Health for vulnerable families.
- Voted Yes on SB0152 – A patient may access and use an investigational stem cell treatment to treat severe chronic disease or terminal illness.
- Voted Yes on SB0281 – the department of environment and conservation cannot regulate farming activities regarding topsoil, rock removal, or building of a pond if area is less than 3 acres and is considered a greenbelt area.
- Voted Yes on SB0837 – Codifies the definition of a human being which does not include AI, a computer algorithm, software program or any type of machine.
- Voted Yes on SB0936 – The policy of this state is that there are only two sexes, a biological male and a biological female.
- Voted Yes on SB1142 – Each utility system shall obtain a certificate of analysis for any water sold by the utility system that contains fluoride.
- Voted Yes on SB1486 – Law enforcement is required to accept & honor immigration detainees.
- Voted Yes on SB1587 – Illegal immigrants cannot lawfully operate a commercial motor vehicle in TN.
- Voted Yes on SB1659 – Aggravating circumstances such as rape of a child under 4 and/or incest will be included for jury consideration.
- Voted Yes on SB1714 – A public school shall be allowed to teach except where personal exceptions are requested, the bible as literature.
- Voted Yes on SB1815 – Coercive suicide is an offense that will be charged for anyone who using AI encourages, advises someone to attempt or commit suicide.
- Voted Yes on SB1847 – Deadly force is allowed in order to protect your property if you or others are in imminent danger.
- Voted Yes on SB1947 – A blood bank/hospital must allow a patient to use their own blood which has been saved.
- Voted Yes on SB1989 – A parent may raise their child according to biological sex and decline gender transformation legally.
- Voted Yes on SB2118 – TennCare will not provide coverage or reimbursement if the procedure is for gender dysphoria or gender identity disorder.
- Voted Yes on SB2172 – Expands the designation of scenic rivers that will not allow a landfill for solid or hazardous wastes to be established near its boundaries. This would include the Big South Fork of the Cumberland River.
- Voted Yes on SB2327 – It is a misdemeanor offense to interfere, obstruct or disturb a religious institution's activities by displaying, uttering or gesturing in a manner that is offensive.
- Voted Yes on SB2335 – Adds the offense of aggravated criminal trespass to include disruption of a religious assembly.
- Voted Yes on SB2644 – Protects TN citizens/residents from transnational repression by foreign govt/terrorist organizations.
