### NAUGHTY & NICE — Notable Votes & Sponsorships

- Voted No on SB0474 – NAUGHTY: Prohibits health care provider from asking if patient has or can obtain firearms.
- Voted No on SB2040 – NAUGHTY: Starting Jan 1 2027, no pharmacy benefits mgr. may directly or indirectly hold, control or otherwise possess any ownership or benefit in a pharmacy license or license holder.
- Voted Yes on SB2153 – NAUGHTY: Early childhood mental health home visiting program will be established by the Dept of Health for vulnerable families.
- Voted Yes on SB1947 – A blood bank/hospital must allow a patient to use their own blood which has been saved.
- Voted Yes on SB1889 – An individual who cannot speak or read English proficiently will be issued a restricted driver's license for one year then they must retake the written drivers test in English only.
- Voted Yes on SB2118 – TennCare will not provide coverage or reimbursement if the procedure is for gender dysphoria or gender identity disorder.
- Voted Yes on SB0152 – A patient may access and use an investigational stem cell treatment to treat severe chronic disease or terminal illness.
- Voted Yes on SB1889 – A restricted driver's license will be issued for one year only for individuals who don't speak or read English.
- Voted Yes on SB1748 – An "out of service order" will be issued to a commercial driver who is unable to read and speak English.
- Killed SB1092 – Legislation to restore Tennessee state sovereignty; refused to 2nd the bill in committee.
- Killed SB1111 – Legislation to restore Tennessee state sovereignty; refused to 2nd the bill in committee. Massey was chair and did not allow voting, sent to General Sub.
- Voted NO on SB0836 – Schools refusing enrollment to students unlawfully present in the United States.
