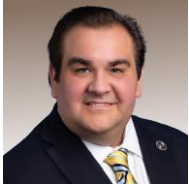

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NAUGHTY & NICE — Notable Votes & Sponsorships

- Voted Yes on SB0162 – Prohibits fluoride from being added to public water systems.
- Voted Yes on SB0281 – the department of environment and conservation cannot regulate farming activities regarding topsoil, rock removal, or building of a pond if area is less than 3 acres and is considered a greenbelt area.
- Voted Yes on SB1142 – Each utility system shall obtain a certificate of analysis for any water sold by the utility system that contains fluoride.
- Voted Yes on SB1748 – An “out of service order” will be issued to a commercial driver who is unable to read and speak English.
- Voted Yes on SB1889 – A restricted driver’s license will be issued for one year only for individuals who don’t speak or read English.
- Voted Yes on SB2172 – Expands the designation of scenic rivers that will not allow a landfill for solid or hazardous wastes to be established near its boundaries. This would include the Big South Fork of the Cumberland River.
