NAUGHTY & NICE — Notable Votes & Sponsorships

- Voted Yes on SB1495 – NAUGHTY: Alvogen, Inc., Apotex Corp., and Zydus Pharmaceuticals (USA) Inc are included to be excused from pending or future opioid claims.
- Voted Yes on SB1868 – NAUGHTY: A child who has exhibited or threatened violent behavior is one who is in need of heightened supervision.
- SPONSOR – Voted Yes on SB1958 – NAUGHTY: Bill will prevent organizations/citizens from suing regarding unconstitutional legislation unless they have standing. Bill Amended to read: Specifies that such cause of action does not apply to challenges to the validity or constitutionality of state law.
- Voted Yes on SB2247 – NAUGHTY: Awards 15,000 additional education scholarships in the 26/27 school year under the One, Big, Beautiful Act if Governor complies w/ all requirements of the Fed.
- Voted No on SB0043 – Allows a county to deny an individuals' 2nd amendment lawful right to carry unless they have a permit.
- Voted Yes on SB0350 – A landlord cannot deny a tenant on leased property from lawfully possessing, carrying, storing a firearm or ammunition.
- Voted Yes on SB0672 – It will be a Class C misdemeanor offense if an individual intentionally obstructs a highway, street, or other place used for the passage of vehicles.
- Voted Yes on SB0777 – Candidates must remove their election signs within 2 weeks after elections. (Caption bill: Requires an individual to register as a member of a statewide political party, a recognized minor party, or as unaffiliated, at the time of initial registration).
- Voted Yes on SB0836 – Public schools and public charter may refuse to enroll illegal aliens.
- Voted Yes on SB0837 – Codifies the definition of a human being which does not include AI, a computer algorithm, software program or any type of machine.
- Voted Yes on SB0936 – The policy of this state is that there are only two sexes, a biological male and a biological female.
- Voted Yes on SB1486 – Law enforcement is required to accept & honor immigration detainers.
- Voted Yes on SB1587 – Illegal immigrants cannot lawfully operate a commercial motor vehicle in TN.
- Voted Yes on SB1659 – Aggravating circumstances such as rape of a child under 4 and/or incest will be included for jury consideration.
- Voted Yes on SB1664 – Healthcare providers cannot ask a minor any gender-related question unless by parent permission.
- Voted Yes on SB1714 – A public school shall be allowed to teach except where personal exceptions are requested, the bible as literature.
- Voted Yes on SB1743 – A wrongful death of an unborn child beginning at fertilization is included in the definition for wrongful death action.
- Voted Yes on SB1779 – It's a state-level offense to intentionally remain in the country in violation of a final deportation order, or to intentionally enter the country illegally.
- Voted Yes on SB1815 – Coercive suicide is an offense that will be charged for anyone who using AI encourages, advises someone to attempt or commit suicide.
- Voted Yes on SB1847 – Deadly force is allowed in order to protect your property if you or others are in imminent danger.
- Voted Yes on SB1989 – A parent may raise their child according to biological sex and decline gender transformation legally.
- Voted Yes on SB2424 – Foreign entities are prohibited from acquiring interests in non-agricultural land.
- Voted Yes on SB2644 – Protects TN citizens/residents from transnational repression by foreign govt/terrorist organizations.
